Content	What is meant by bullying and cyber bullying and how to recognise these behaviours, practical work, case scenarios and discussion, sharing best practices in bullying prevention and response, cultural and social perspectives and data on bullying, different forms of bullying – when are behaviours more than simple bullying;, activities to empower a safe classroom environment and develop social competences, cultural and social perspectives of cyber bullying;
Methodology	The standard methodology is highly practical and participative with hands-on approach that comprises real-job examples, case studies examination and simulations. We embrace collaboratively working methods that foster mutual learning and cooperation among participants. Our focus is on learning in an interactive and international environment knowledge applicable to the real contexts and/or in the classroom. The pedagogical methods that we use are based upon experiential training, group and peer activities, learning-by-doing and best practices’ exchange. They include visits with local schools and institutions allowing the participants to better understand the local education system as well as exchange ideas and contacts.

Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to understand conflict – causes, manifestations and how to turn it into a teaching moment; • to learn practical approaches for incorporating conflict management into curriculum; • to use effective, practical communication tools for better school relations and community building; • to develop emotional and social intelligence skills – how to enhance and foster them in yourself and others; • to understand relational aggression and bullying – school-wide approaches for awareness and prevention; • to apply hands-on, practical activities to favor wellbeing, group cohesion, sense of belonging in the school community
Content	<p>Various types of conflict and how to use them as an opportunity for growth; Lesson and discussion about group dynamics, positive and negative outcomes of conflict, aggressive behavior, bullying and various ‘roles’ played by group members; Lesson and experiences regarding classroom cohesion, importance of forming a ‘team’; empathy, active listening and reformulation as powerful tools in diffusing conflict and strengthening relationships; strategies such as peer mediation, circle time activities, class diary, etc. and how to use them effectively in the classroom; Simulation of lessons by course members using tools and abilities for creating an emotionally caring environment;</p>
Methodology	<p>Through hands-on, practical activities that can be immediately used in the classroom, participants will increase their own ability to model and encourage active listening, empathy, and emotional literacy among today’s students – and tomorrow’s active citizens</p>
